



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HIGH STREET, TARRANT MONKTON**

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along HIGH STREET, TARRANT MONKTON between its junctions with Turners Lane and the village street, a distance of approximately 700 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on Thursday 05 April 2018 and will remain in force for 5 days. However it is anticipated that the works will take place on Thursday 05 and Friday 06 April 2018, between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs daily.

**This Notice will enable BT Openreach safe access to to access their overhead network for cabling purposes.**

Alternative routes will be sign posted as indicated by the blue line on the map below.
